This is an opportunity for you to take the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery test and receive recognition. This test is designed to help you begin exploring careers and planning for your future. It is also the Armed Forces Qualification Test which is used to determine your qualification for entry into any branch of the United States Armed Forces or the Coast Guard.

How:

1. Listen to the Daily announcements in your period 2 tutorial/enrichment class for test dates.
2. See Mr. Rosen in the career center for more information.
3. Log on to www.asvabprogram.com for complete details.
4. Check out the sample test on-line to get an idea of what the test is all about.

Follow the directions below once you find out when and where the test will take place.

1. Sign up!!!! (There are deadlines)
2. Get permission from your teachers.
3. Be sure to show up on time on the day of your test.
